The European Central Bank (ECB) is tendering out the supply of electricity for the buildings located at its main address (Sonnemannstraße 20, 60314 Frankfurt-on-Main, GERMANY) and at the location 'Japan Center' (Taunustor 2, 60311 Frankfurt-on-Main, GERMANY). The main building is located in the eastern part of the city while the Japan Center is located in the city centre. The area where the buildings are is around 120 000 m². The total surface in the buildings is around 190 000 m².

27,7 GWh is estimated per year for the main building while 1,3 GWh is estimated for the Japan Center. The ECB requires regenerative (green) power supply and that the tenderer has supplied this kind of supply in the past as stated in the procurement documents.

- (d) they have shown significant or persistent deficiencies in the performance of another public contract, or with their obligations under environmental, social and labour law;
- (e) they or their management, staff or agents are subject to a conflict of interest that cannot be remedied by less intrusive means;
- (f) they are guilty of serious misrepresentation in supplying the information required by the ECB; or
- (g) they contact other candidates or tenderers with the purpose of restraining competition, or try to unduly influence the decision-making process in the procurement procedure.

Tenderers shall certify that they are not in one of the situations listed above and provide the evidence specified in the contract notice or invitation to tender. If such circumstances arise in the course of the procedure the tenderer concerned shall inform the ECB thereof without undue delay.
