Description of requested change:

There is discrepancy between UHB field description and T2S GUI. The check box name in the GUI needs to be amended from 'Conditional Settlement' to 'CoSD Processing'.

For harmonisation reasons, the screen "CoSD Rules - List Screen" should also contain the label "CoSD Processing" label instead of "Conditional Settlement".

Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

To avoid misunderstandings the name of the check box needs to be updated to be in line with the field description of the UHB.

Proposed wording for the Change request:

The name of the check box mentioned on the CoSD Rule – New/Edit Screen needs to be amended from 'Conditional Settlement' to 'CoSD Processing' as stated in the field description of the UHB.



Outcome/Decisions:

- * CRG on 14 July 2016: During a written procedure from 12 14 July 2016, the CRG recommended to launch the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- * OMG in a written procedure from 5 to 12 August 2016: The Operations Managers Group confirmed that the Change Request does not have any operational impact.
- * Advisory Group on 18 August 2016: Following a written procedure from 12 to 18 August 2016, the Advisory Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- * CSD Steering Group on 19 August 2016: Following a written procedure from 12 to 19 August 2016, the CSD Steering Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
