Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

The current implementation of the Securities Accounts functionalities foresees that, when creating/updating the associated Restriction Types, the same Restriction Type cannot be applied twice in the same period of time. A specific check is performed in order to avoid that the validity periods of the same Restriction Type can overlap.

This check should be more restrictive when an Earmarking is applied. In fact, the system should prevent the possibility to earmark the Securities Account applying two distinct earmarking restrictions at the same time.

Description of requested change:

The current implementation of the Securities Accounts functionalities foresees that, when creating/updating the Restriction Types, the overlapping period is checked as follows:

"In case of request for creation/update of Securities Account Restriction, the restriction type must not overlap with any other Securities Account Restriction already defined or in input flow having the same [Restriction Type]".

The check for the Restriction Types having the "Securities Position" Object Restriction Type should avoid to overlap any other possible Restriction with the same Object Restriction Type.

For the Restriction Types with Object Restriction Type equal to "Securities Account", the current check must remain as it is now.

Proposed wording for the Change request:

The relevant Business Rules must be amended in the chapters "4.1 Index of Business Rules and Error Codes" of the UDFS and "6.4.2.155 Securities Account - New/Edit Screen" of the UHB.

DAC1025

When performing a Securities Account Create request, <u>lin</u> case of request for creation of Securities Account Restriction <u>having Object Restriction Type equal to Securities Account</u>, the created restriction type must not overlap with any other Securities Account Restriction in input having the same [Restriction Type]. <u>In case of request for creation of Securities Account Restriction having Object Restriction Type equal to Securities Position, the created restriction type must not overlap with any other Securities Account Restriction in input having the same Object Restriction Type.</u>

DAU1025

When performing a Securities Account Update request, ½n case of request for creation/update of Securities Account Restriction having Object Restriction Type equal to Securities Account, the restriction type must not overlap with any other Securities Account Restriction already defined or in input flow having the same {Restriction Type}. In case of request for creation/update of Securities Account Restriction having Object Restriction Type equal to Securities Position, the restriction type must not overlap with any other Securities Account Restriction already defined or in input flow having the same Object Restriction Type.

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High level description of Impact:

In the Securities Account create and update functionality, the processing for Business Rules DAC1025 and DAU1025 must be amended in order to avoid overlapping of two Restriction Types having Object Restriction Type equal to Securities Position, whatever their Restriction Type is.

Outcome/Decisions:

- * CRG on 14 July 2016: During a written procedure from 12 14 July 2016, the CRG recommended to launch the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- * OMG in a written procedure from 5 to 12 August 2016: The Operations Managers Group confirmed that the Change Request does not have any operational impact.
- * Advisory Group on 18 August 2016: Following a written procedure from 12 to 18 August 2016, the Advisory Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- * CSD Steering Group on 19 August 2016: Following a written procedure from 12 to 19 August 2016, the CSD Steering Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- * CRG meeting of 6 September 2016: The CRG recommended the approval of the Change Request and its inclusion in the T2S Release 1.3.
- * OMG on 16 September 2016: During a written procedure from to 31 August to 16 September 2016, the Operations Managers Group did not identify any blocking operational impact of the Change Request. The OMG was in favour of adding the Change Request to Release 1.3.
- * Advisory Group on 20 September 2016: Following a written procedure from 14 to 20 September 2016, the AG was in favour of approving the Change Request and its inclusion on T2S Release 1.3.
- * CSD Steering Group on 21 September 2016: During the CSG meeting on 21 September 2016, the CSG adopted the resolution to approve the Change Request and its inclusion on T2S Release 1.3.
