Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

From a business perspective, within T2S, the trade date within a Settlement Instruction must always be populated by the sender. Currently, within a settlement instruction message (Securities Settlement Transaction Instruction (sese.023), the trade date is an optional element. The Business Rule MVCV227 ('The Trade Date of the Settlement Instruction is not informed') exists within T2S to ensure that the element is populated but this Business Rule is circumvented by the fact that at the interface level the trade date is populated by '0001-01-01' when it is absent from the incoming message. This default value is not appropriate from a business point of view and T2S must ensure that an actual trade date is always provided by the sender.

The requested change is that the trade date within a settlement instruction (Securities Settlement Transaction Instruction - sese.023) is always populated by the sender.

Description of requested change:

To ensure that the trade date is always populated by the sender the trade date must be made mandatory within the T2S customised schema of the Settlement Instruction (Securities Settlement Transaction Instruction - sese.023)
As a consequence the Business Rules MVCV227 and can be removed.

OVERVIEW OF THE IMPACT OF THE REQUEST ON THE T2S SYSTEM AND ON THE PROJECT

Summary of functional, development, infrastructure and migration impacts

This CR aims at including the validation of the presence of the trade date directly within the message schema by rendering the element mandatory (currently optional). The business validation is currently accomplished by a BR MVCV227. This BR is to be eliminated.

Main Cost Drivers:

- Customisation of sese.023 usage guideline on MyStandards
- Testing of the new validation and regression testing

An impact on ECMS was identified as the sese.023 schema will be modified, and this is a message ECMS uses with its counterparties and for communications with T2S.
