The new SETT BR SXAA036 introduced by PBI-227593 violates camt.025, the complete error text containing 141 characters instead of 140 allowed in the respective field. The camt.025 will be rejected as non compliant with xsd schema.

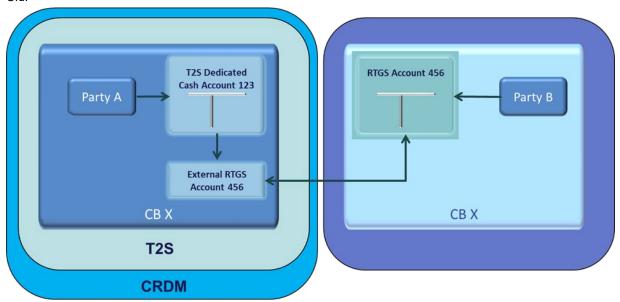

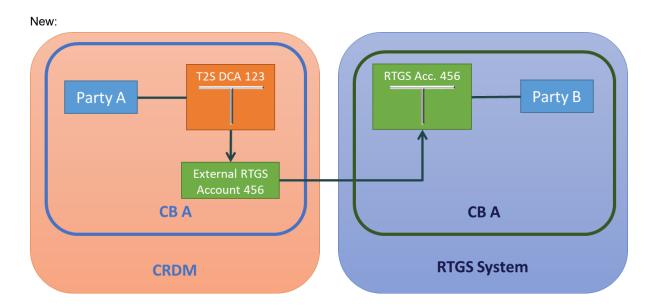

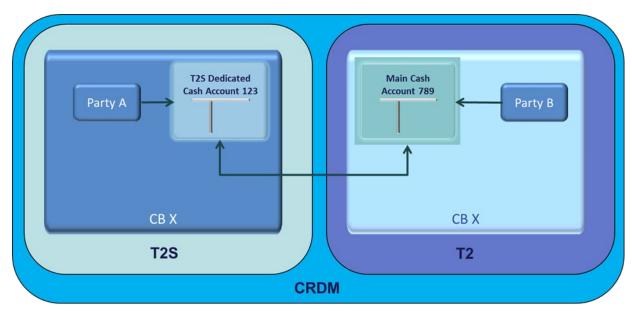

EXAMPLE 45 - LINKS BETWEEN T2S DEDICATED CASH ACCOUNTS AND RTGS ACCOUNTS Old:

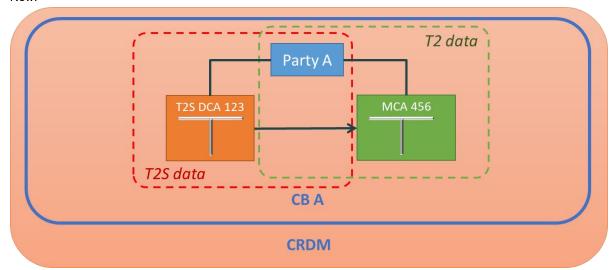




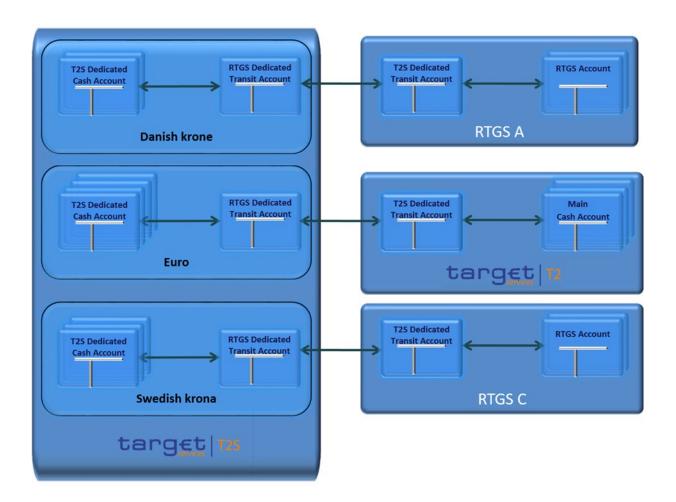

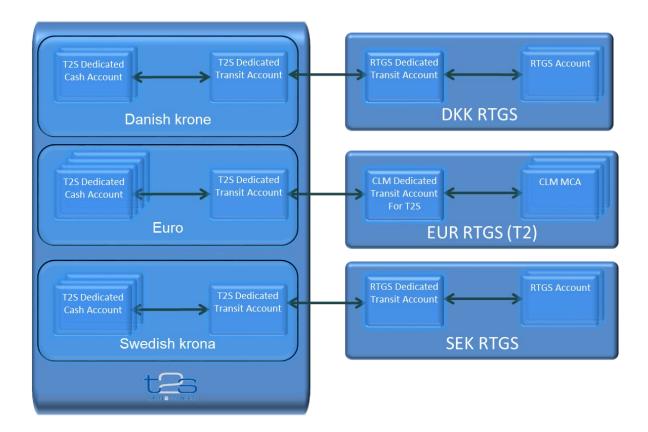

This implies that T2S does not move the liquidity to be transferred directly from a given T2S dedicated cash account to its corresponding MCA or RTGS account. On the contrary, the retransfer of liquidity is based on the following three-step process:

- I T2S moves the liquidity to be reimbursed from the given T2S dedicated cash account to the RTGS T2S dedicated transit account denominated in the same currency. The transit account is a T2S account which mirrors the transit account in the RTGS system;
- I An outbound liquidity transfer for cash sweep is initiated from T2S to T2 or other RTGS. The liquidity is transferred from this RTGS dedicated transit account in T2S to the corresponding T2S CLM dedicated transit account for T2S in T2 or to other destination RTGS system;

Finally, the liquidity is moved from the T2S dedicated transit account in T2 or to other destination RTGS system to the relevant MCA or RTGS account.

In the predefined DWH T2S report INX09 currently two references are reported: The Liquidity transfer instructor reference and the referred reference. The first is not filled in case of T2S generated LTO and the latter is only filled in case an LTO is linked to a settlement instruction which is not the case in most instances. This leads to the problem, that for many LTOs no reference is provided at all which makes it difficult for customers to allocate such LTOs to transactions in their books

With PBI000000223988 and PBI000000224718 a software fix was introduced in order to realign A2A behaviour with GUI. This behaviour was the one originally intended for CRDM. Therefore, no SDD update was deemed to be necessary.

Editorial update of parties and access rights for T2S DWH usage

The DWH consolidates the content of the sources into a single database for reporting purposes and offers predefined reports to the users of the following T2S parties:

- Central Banks (CB),
- Central Securities Depositories (CSD)
- External CSDs (eCSD),
- Payment Banks (PB).

The precondition for a user to obtain access to the DWH is a setup in CRDM by the respective party. Access to the DWH depends on the user's profile, which ensures that the user is allowed to perform the requested action(s). There are two user profiles reflected as privileges in CRDM:

Normal user profile: will be available for all party types CB/CSD users only.

16 Clarification Note- ICN-0017-T2-88- Participant Invoices in DKK

Impact clarification note related to T2-0088 and the impact in CoCo (CRDM).

In the T2-T2S Consolidation (CSLD) project there are foreseen a few Change Requests related to the onboarding onto T2 of the Danmarks Nationalbank (DKCB) and of the Danish community. Among those Change Requests, CSLD CR-0088 envisions the use of the Billing common component (BILL) for the Danmarks Nationalbank.

The configuration required for DKCB is to register two different System Entities in CRDM defined in two different currencies, the first one in Euro (EUR), the second one in Danish Krone (DKK). The process of invoice generation for DKK (and in general for a non-EUR System Entity) will follow the steps below:

- 1. The consumption and invoice data for the System entity and Participant invoice (billable items, quantities, corrections etc.) are computed as the standard BILL process;
- 2. The System Entity invoice (i.e. the invoice for the Central Bank) will be computed in EUR;
- 3. For Participant invoices (i.e. the invoices of parties under the data scope of the National Central Bank) the latest available Euro foreign Exchange rate in CRDM for the relevant currency is retrieved;
- 4. The Participant invoices (PDF and camt.077) will be generated in the non-EUR currency applying the exchange rate to the already computed invoiced data in EUR;
- 5. if properly configured, the Direct Debit will be sent to CLM using the non-euro currency total invoice amount present in the Participant Invoice.

According to these above steps, no change is foreseen on BILL side from CSLD CR-0088 for System Entity invoices, both in EUR and non-EUR currencies, and for EUR Participant invoices, while an impact on the invoice calculation for non-EUR Participant invoices is foreseen.

For this reason, since in T2S is it not allowed to issue Participant invoices for CSD Participants, the changes stemming from CSLD CR-0088 have no impact on CSD side.

T2S users are invited to take note of the changes listed above.

Changes to BILL will be released according to the T2.2024.JUN / T2S.2024.JUN schedule within Package 1, i.e. deployment in EAC is planned on 2 February 2024, UTEST is planned to take place on 12 April 2024 and delivery to PROD is planned on 8 June 2024.

1.5.8. Invoice creation

[...]

The invoice creation process foresees that:

- each calculated invoice is enriched with header information (e.g. a unique invoice number – unique and sequential for Service and Country-, the information on sender and receiver, the relevant billing period);

- BILL assigns the invoice a due date on the basis of the invoice creation date, the T2 calendar and due date offsets (System Entity and Participant) specified as a number of business days and defined in CRDM;
- in case the invoice is issued to participants of a CB with a non-EUR currency, BILL translates on the fly all amounts and prices in the destination currency;
- the calculated invoices are stored as PDF document.

1.5.8.1 Invoice template

Within the PDF invoice, the reported amounts for each service item are rounded to the second decimal digit. However, the total amount of the invoice is based on the unrounded figures of the underlying service items and therefore the sum of the underlying service items (rounded to two decimal digits) may not match with the total amount of the invoice (rounded to two decimal digits).

Whenever reported in the pdf, the currency symbol is the EUR (€) except for the invoices of non-EUR CB participants with translated prices and amounts where the currency symbol is set according to currency configured for the CB.

1.5.9. Invoice sending

[...]

BILL generates the invoices of the CB participants. Furthermore, CBs are allowed to opt for the direct invoicing to their Participants: in this case, all invoices charged by CBs to their CB participants are sent out directly to each Participant. Each CB can then download the invoices related to their participants in the BILL GUI.

For participants of a CB with a non-EUR currency BILL generates both PDF and BillingReport camt.077 INVC with all amounts and prices in the destination currency translated on the fly from the original amount in EUR.

1.5.10. Direct Debiting

Central Banks can configure the automatic sending of Direct Debit (DD) for the charging of the invoices sent to their Participants for each service.

Billing creates DD orders on the invoice due date and submits them to CLM, to debit the participant predefined account for debits and credit the predefined account for credits, as configured in CRDM.

For CB Participants of a non-EUR currency CB, the Direct Debit message (pacs.010) created by BILL for each Participant under the CB scope has the following features:

- The Interbank Settlment Amount currency has currency attribute equal to the non-EUR currency and value equal to the amount to be charged translated on the fly in the destination currency from EUR
- Settlement date is equal to the calculated due date. If the due date is a closing date for the non-EUR currency calendar, the settlement date is set to the earliest following business date in which the non-EUR currency is opened for the settlement of Direct Debit in CLM (The due date in the invoice still remains the one related to the EUR calendar)

<u>Direct Debit for non-EUR currencies will always be sent by BILL to CLM, meaning that it is not possible to send a Direct Debit to any other RTGS.</u>
