
#### Share of firms reporting undertaking measures to increase supply chain resilience












# Shift to hybrid working will boost exports of services from emerging Europe





# Getting old before getting rich





# Demographic constraints eased by influx of refugees from Ukraine




# Self-assessed health in the new EU Member States on par with G7






# Much worse self-reported health in the EU Candidate Countries




# Self-reported health in the EU Candidate Countries similar to Emerging Markets



# Labour force participation in the new EU Member States similar to G7




# Much lower labour force participation among women in Candidate Countries
